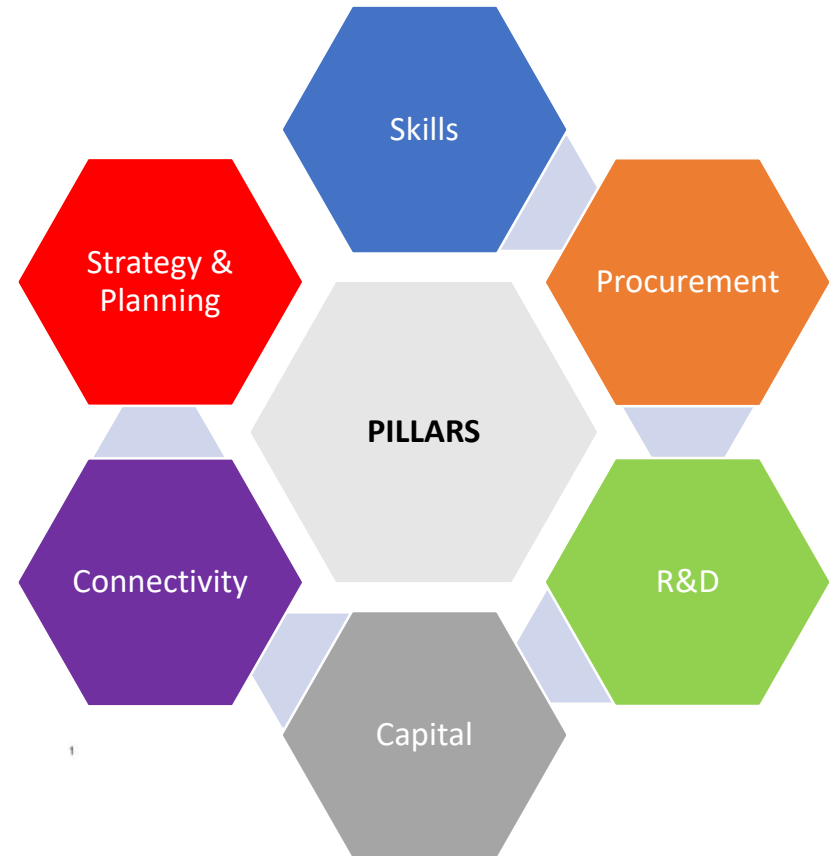

## Highlights

1. **Plymouth** selected to be the **SW Regional Testing Hub**, part of the **biggest diagnostic lab network in British history**
2. Construction work is all but complete. Some equipment has arrived on site, and training has begun
3. Going to be live 15th Feb – processing tests
4. AI software processing 80% of throughput but need qualified people to deal with the remaining 20%
5. Located in Estover at the former Underhill Site
6. NHS Operated

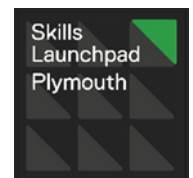

## Highlights

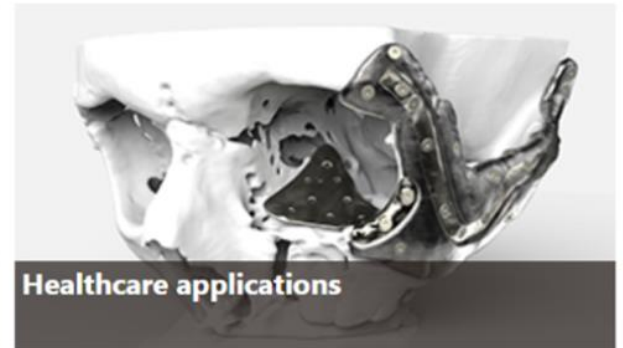
1. **£1.038m Grant** offer from Getting Building Fund, via HoTSWLEP plus revenue Grant from UoP
2. Clean room laboratories for life sciences
3. 3D printing in Stainless, Aluminium and Titanium (One dedicated medical device and one R&D)
4. R&D 3D printing can be available to other sectors (Defence, Marine, Manufacturing)
5. Operational from Q1 FY21/22.

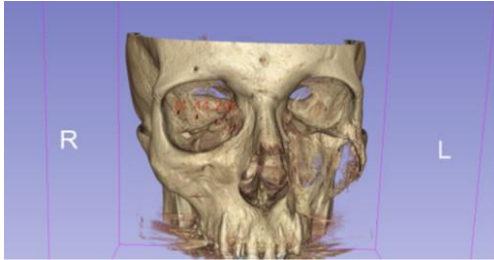

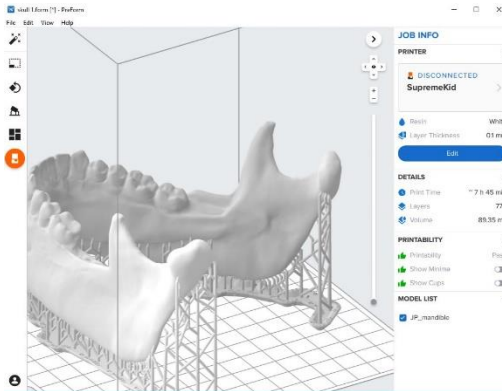

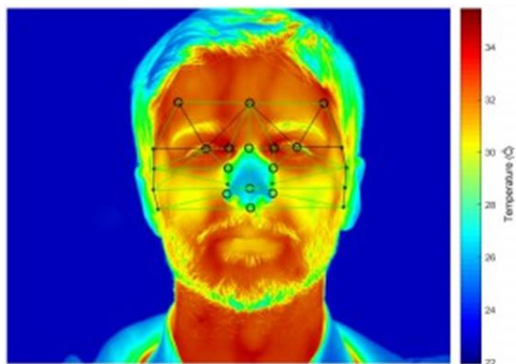
